Minutes of 26th September 2014

1. The following change was agreed, responsibility for 'Historic Environment and Landscape Character' policies is with Danusia Morsley not Patrick Wingfield.

Matters Arising

- 2. Website
 - a. The Steering Group was reminded of note on the structure, naming and information to be supplied for any document or file to be put on the website.
 - b. It was agreed that 'Dropbox' should be used to share documents amongst members of the Steering Group. Each document put in Dropbox is to have a front page with the website information that will be required when the document is mounted on the website.
- 3. Recruitment of Administrator/Research Assistant

A draft advert (see attached) was agreed with the following additions

- The person should be self-employed
- The hours were variable with some evening work
- The responsibility for securing the material that will be required to be submitted to West Berkshire and the Independent examiner

- 4. Approach to Doctor's Surgery and Schools Outstanding
- 5. Meeting with Developers- Barton Willmore (who act on behalf of Hallam Land Management) will be offered 3rd,4th, or 6th of November 2014 for a meeting. **Action Mike Dennett.**
- 6. Identification of Small Sites It was noted that Neighbourhood Development Orders can be used for example to convert spaces above shops into flats. This might be an opportunity for dwellings in Mortimer. It was also noted that the 40% affordable housing can put off landowner from offering up land for development.

Development of policies

- 7. It was agreed three key lessons from the Ascot Sunningdale presentation were "not to leave 'wriggle room' in the policy statements", "the need for adequate resources" and that "a central objective/policy can provide the focus for the whole NDP" that engages the community in a positive purpose, e.g. the rejuvenation of the area South of the racecourse.
- 8. The proposals for combining the policy ideas to reduce the total number that have to be developed were accepted and allocated to specific themes to do the amalgamation (see attached)
- 9. To enable Danusia Morsely to concentrate on communicating with and contacting the stakeholders in Mortimer it was agreed that Tennant Barber would develop the 'Commercial and Employment' policies and Patrick Wingfield the 'Historic Environment and Landscape Character' polices.

West Berkshire Housing in the Countryside Consultation

11. It was reported that the Parish Council had delegated the responsibility for their response to the consultation to the NDP Team. A review of the consultation document highlighted that the policies were so caveated that they became 'toothless'. It was greed this should be the response in a separate letter. A draft is to be produced for Mike Dennett to send on behalf of the team **Action Patrick Wingfield for draft and Mike Dennett.**
